About the survey: The Pre Poll survey was conducted between November 25 and December 1, 2023 among 3097 electors at 120 polling stations spread across 30 assembly constituencies of Telangana. The sampling design adopted was multi-stage systematic random sampling. The Assembly Constituencies were randomly selected using the probability proportional to size method. Thereafter, four polling stations within each of the sampled constituencies were selected using the systematic random sampling method. Within each polling station, 40 electors were randomly sampled from the electoral roll using the systematic random sampling method. Of these 40, 25 interviews were targeted. The interviews of electors were conducted face-to-face at their homes after voting had taken place in their area. The findings shown here have been weighted by gender, religion, locality, and caste group based on Census 2011 data and by the actual vote shares secured by the main parties— Congress, BJP, BRS, AIMIM and Other smaller Parties.
