About the survey: The Maharashtra Assembly Election 2024 pre-poll survey was conducted between November 13 and November 18, 2024 among 3959 electors at 160 polling stations spread across 40 assembly constituencies of Maharashtra. The sampling design adopted was multi-stage systematic random sampling. The Assembly Constituencies were randomly selected using the probability proportional to size method. Thereafter, four polling stations within each of the sampled constituencies were selected using the systematic random sampling method. Within each polling station, 40 electors were randomly sampled from the electoral roll using the systematic random sampling method. Of these 40, 25 interviews were targeted. The interviews of electors were conducted face-to-face at their homes where voting will be taken place in their area. The findings shown here have been weighted by gender, religion, locality, and caste group based on Census 2011 data and by the Actual vote shares secured by the main parties—Maha Yuti Alliance, Maha Vikas Aghadi (India Block) and other smaller parties.
